



The County of Wilson and City of Wilson are NOT under a curfew. The Governor's "Stay at Home" order that goes into effect today at 5 p.m. says you should stay home unless you are doing a permitted activity.

We encourage you to stay home as much as you can for the community's overall health and safety. If you go out, stay 6 feet away from others and wash your hands frequently. Together, we can help keep Wilson County safe for everyone.

Business remaining OPEN during the "Stay at Home" Order – traveling to these businesses is permitted (check the complete list on our site). **NOTE: You DO NOT have to have an authorization letter in your vehicle.**

- Restaurants that provide take-out, drive-thru, or delivery
- Grocery stores
- ABC stores and beer and wine stores
- Doctors and other healthcare providers
- Pharmacies
- Hardware stores
- Post offices
- Office supply stores
- Gas stations and convenience stores
- Veterinarians and pet supply stores
- Hotels, airlines, buses, taxis, and rideshare services
- Places of worship
- Child care providers (that are following the required NCDHHS procedures)
