This way we will be able to reach many more recipients. We will be doing screening for those seniors that are self-isolated, have no transportation and live alone.

There are also many grandparents raising grandchildren in one particular county in NC that are requesting chrome books for their grandchildren if you have those.

Please consider donating your old devices to be refurbished and put to good use instead of lying in a drawer or cluttering up your space.

Items donated need to meet the following criteria:

- iPads cannot be more than 3 to 4 years old
- Laptops must have at least a Windows 7 Operating System
- Please remember to log out of any iPad donated and include any chargers, instructions, boxes and protectors if you still have them.
